

Quick Setup Guide for Tom Tom 3 Bluetooth Kit



Setting up the Receiver for 1st use

1. You must charge the Bluetooth Receiver fully before first using it. Failure to do so may result in reduced battery life. Recommended charge time is 12 hours.
2. If the battery does not charge make sure it is inserted correctly.

Pairing the GPS Receiver with your PDA

1. Switch the power on for your GPS Receiver (the switch is located at the side)
2. Start Bluetooth Manager on your PDA (click the icon on the bottom right of the screen)
3. Bluetooth Manager will ask you if you want to search for new devices. Choose "Yes"
4. It will then say Bluetooth GPS Receiver found
5. You will be asked for a pin code. Enter 2003
6. Put a tick in the box next to the Bluetooth GPS Receiver and then save and choose OK
7. Click on the Bluetooth GPS Receiver in the menu
8. Click on actions and choose 'Connect to SPP Slave'.



Setting up your Tom Tom 3 Software

1. Turn Bluetooth on from your PDA by clicking the Bluetooth icon located at the bottom right corner of the screen and then selecting Bluetooth Radio On. A blue light will flash once you have done this.
2. Install Tom Tom 3 Software from the disc supplied.
3. Install the latest patch for the Tom Tom software by visiting their website at www.tomtom.com.
4. Open the Tom Tom Navigator software and to the GPS status page from the navigator menu
5. Choose the GPS tab at the bottom of the screen
6. Untick the box at the top if it is ticked
7. Choose "Bluetooth Serial Port on COM5" from the dropdown menu and then tick the box to the left.
8. Click on status at the bottom of the screen and you should see black dots moving from left to right between the icons of the satellite dish and the pda.
